

Brighton i360 Drop 360 Waiver

PLEASE READ AND SIGN TO ACCEPT OUR TERMS DETAILED BELOW.

1. There is a weight limit of 125kg excluding equipment provided to you.
2. Brighton i360 staff will always accompany participants during the event except for the time between leaving the Pod and reaching the ground.
3. All participants will be required to wear a safety harness and helmet provided by Brighton i360 for the descent.
4. All participants should wear suitable clothing that will allow you to wear a harness over the top and will not restrict your movement or lead to overheating in warm conditions.
5. All participants should wear practical footwear (no high heels or open toe).
6. No loose items, including cameras and mobile phones, food or beverages can be taken on your person for the Drop 360 activity, but can be left on the Pod and collected at the end of the Drop 360 when the Pod descends.
7. Brighton i360 has the right to stop the experience at any time following any unsafe or negligent behaviour from participants.
8. Brighton i360 has the right to refuse entry without refund to participants who have not complied with these conditions both before and during the climb.
9. Brighton i360 take no responsibility for accidents that may occur during this event because of negligence on behalf of the participant.
10. Participants must not be under the influence of alcohol or legal or illegal substances which would make it unsafe for them to participate in the Drop 360 or to understand the Safety Briefing on the day of the event. Participants may be asked to perform a breathalyser test before they board the Pod.
11. Participants must be over 12 years old. Those aged between 12 and 15 must be accompanied by a paying adult aged 18 or over, on a ratio of 1 adult to up to 2 children aged 12 to 15. Accompanying parents or guardians must sign the parental / guardian consent form for each child in their care.
12. Participants aged 16 and 17 do not need to be accompanied by an adult aged 18+ but their parent or legal guardian is required to sign the Parental Consent form.
13. All participants must be capable of understanding and following instructions given by the Brighton i360 team.

14. The Drop 360 will take place in winds of up to 15 metres per second (measured at the top of the tower). We will not operate the event in winds more than 15m/s, during lightning storms, heavy snow, ice, or extreme weather conditions which we reasonably believe might make it unsafe to Drop from the Pod or land on the Upper deck area. If we have to cancel an event due to weather conditions, tickets will be extended by three months.
15. Due to the live operational nature of Brighton i360, it is possible that advertised dates and timings may be altered. The effect on date and timings is likely to be minimal, and participants will be contacted at the earliest opportunity via email if their Drop 360 is affected. When a service cannot be provided, ticket holders will be informed, and tickets will be extended by three months.
16. When participants arrive late for a Drop 360 event, every effort will be made to include them in the activity. However, due to the live operational nature of Brighton i360, if late participants cannot be accommodated on the Drop 360, their ticket is non-refundable.
17. Toilet facilities are not available during the Drop 360 but are available to use within the Brighton i360 building and The Deck before and after the experience.
